Tipitaka -> Sutta Pitaka -> Khuddaka Nikaya. The word Khuddaka means small or minor. Khuddaka Nikaya is the "Minor collection". This is a heterogeneous mix of sermons, doctrines, stories, incidents, talks and poetry attributed to the Buddha and his disciples. Buddha had instructed Ananda (who compiled all teachings) that the Minor collection be given lower importance (probably because many texts are in form of stories & many are hyperbolic).
