In cases where a defect in the product's design caused injury there are two important standards Pennsylvania courts use to determine product liability: The Consumer Expectations Standard-This standard asks whether the product is more dangerous than the reasonable consumer would expect. A reasonable consumer would expect a knife blade to be sharp, for example, and might not be able to recover for their cut hand.
